Fall Tips

1. **Clean leaves and debris from your gutters** ensure no standing water is left so it does not freeze
2. **Check the ventilation in the attic** ice build up on roofs are often caused by poor ventilation
3. **Make sure the caulking around doors and windows is adequate** this will help to reduce heat loss. Ensure they are in good shape for end-of-season problems
4. **Take in patio furniture and other outdoor items** so they do not get damaged by rain, wind, snow, etc
5. **Make sure that the caulking around your bathroom fixtures is adequate** this will prevent water from seeping into the sub-flooring
